




1. Assemble double-ended stud to T-Anchor. See figure 1




2. Locate trim plug at rear of trunk opening. Remove with trim plug removal tool and discard. See f








3. Pull back trim panel and locate trim panel bracket. Attach panel clip nut over top hole in bracket, making sure hole in bracket lines up with panel nut threaded hole. See figure 3
