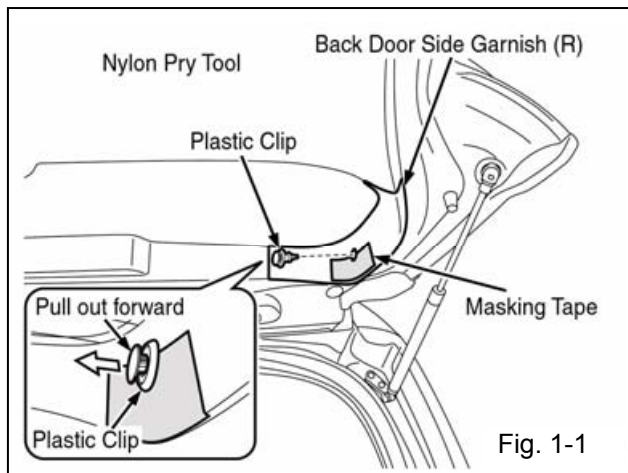
Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

This document covers such items as:-

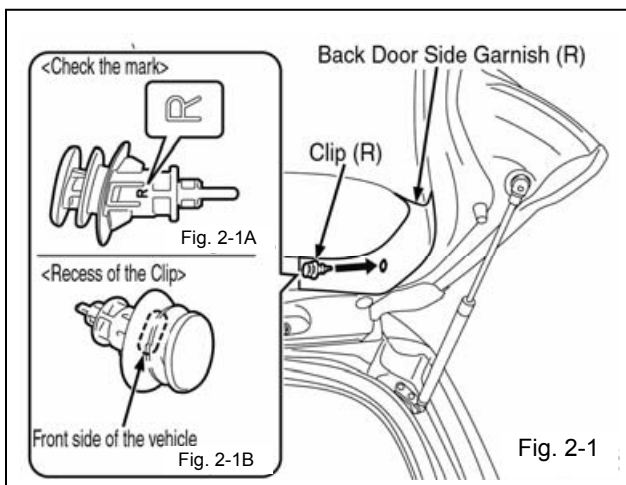
- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Removal of Plastic Clip

- (a) Put the masking tape around the plastic clip.
- (b) Using the nylon pry tool pull out the tip of the plastic clip and remove from the back door side garnish (Right side). (Fig. 1-1)
- (c) In the same way, remove the plastic clip from the back door side garnish (Left side).

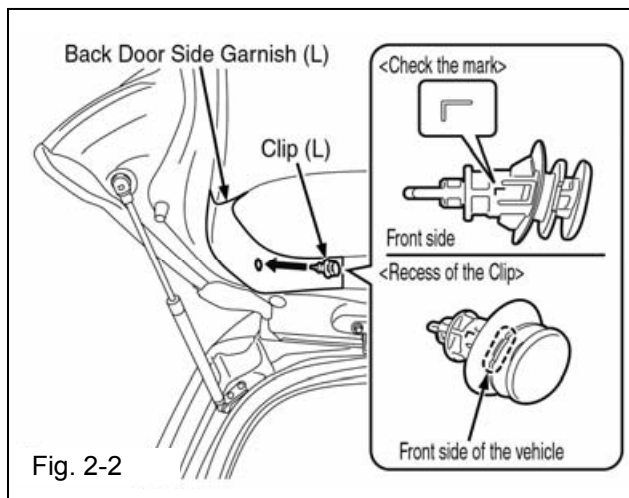


2. Installation of Cargo Cover Clip

NOTE: Cargo cover clips have a (R) mark for the right hand side clip and a (L) for the left hand side clip.

- (a) Install right side clip as shown in Fig. 2-1.

NOTE: Make sure the (R) mark faces the rear of the vehicle (Fig. 2-1A) and the recess of the clip faces the front side of the vehicle (Fig. 2-1B).



(b) Install left side clip. (Fig. 2-2)

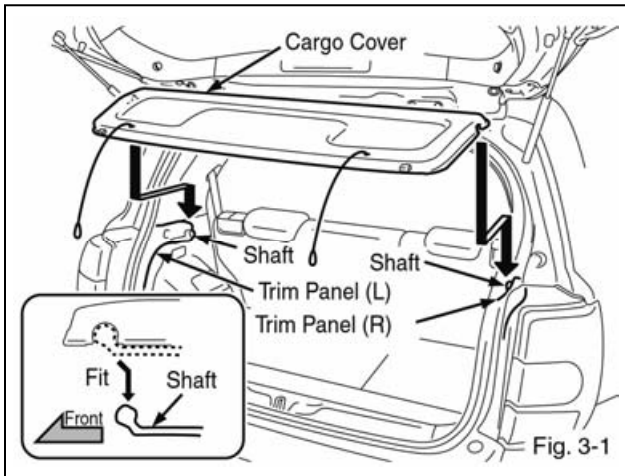


NOTE: For left hand clip the (L) mark and the recess faces the front of the vehicle.

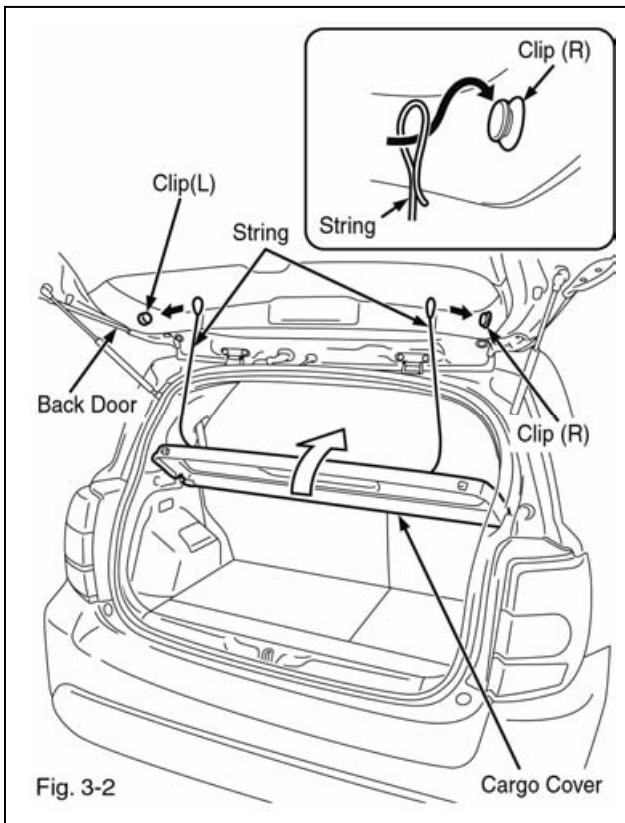
(c) Push firmly on the clip face to lock in clip.

3. Installation of Cargo Cover

- (a) Fit both ends (recesses) of the cargo cover onto the shafts of the trim panels (R and L). (Fig. 3-1)



- (b) Hook the pieces of string from the cargo cover to the clips (R and L) of the backdoor. (Fig. 3-2)



Checklist - these points **MUST** be checked to ensure a quality installation.

Check:

- Installation of R and L clips
- Installation of strings
- Opening and closing the back door
- Inspection of vehicle for damage and dirt
- Cargo Cover function

Look For:

Ensure that the clips are securely fixed.

Ensure that the cargo cover strings are securely hooked to the clips.

Ensure that the door opens and closes smoothly.

Visually inspect for damage.

Cargo cover lifts smoothly when the back door opens.

Cargo cover seats properly when the back door closes.
