 **SAFETY TORQUE:** This mark indicates that torque is related to safety.

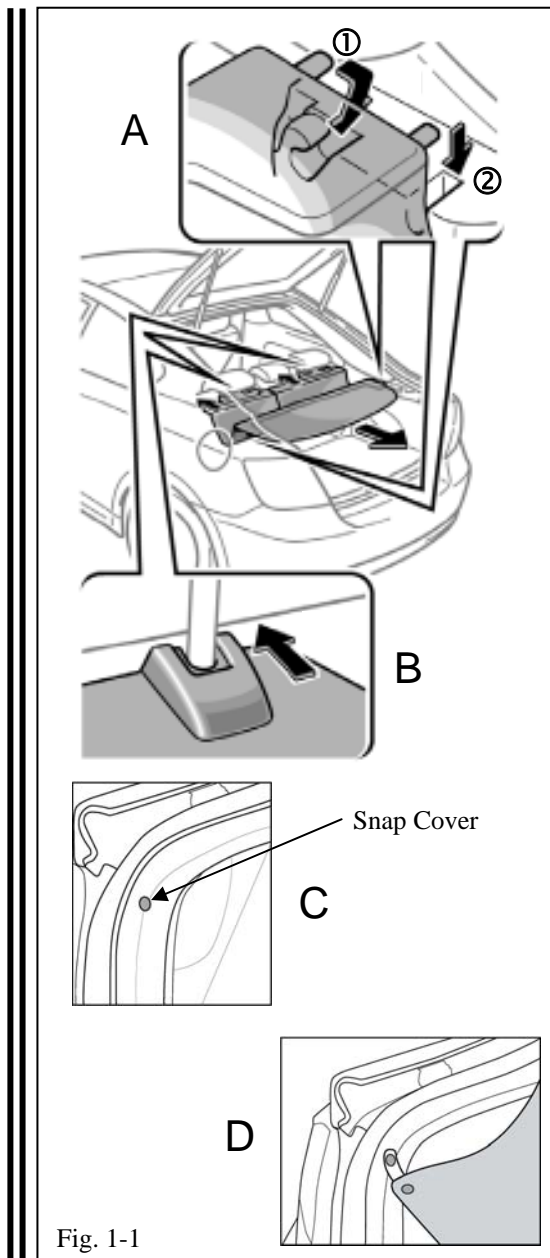
Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

This document covers such items as:-


- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Installation of Cargo Cover

(a) Open vehicle rear cargo door and locate the Cargo Cover mounting points on the driver and passenger side of the cargo compartment.

 (b) Place the left and right end of cargo cover support forward pin into the mounting point ①. Then rotate the cover down to place the support rear pin ② into the slot. (Fig. 1-1A)

 (c) Clip the hooks on the head restraint. (4 places). (Fig 1-1B)

 (d) Remove the snap covers located on the rear trim panel (2 places). (Fig 1-1C)

 (e) Attach the rear retention snaps. (Fig. 1-1D)

Checklist - these points **MUST** be checked to ensure a quality installation.

Accessory Function Checks

- Confirm the cover is attached properly to the anchor points in the vehicle.

Make sure the support pins are fully seated in the anchor points, clips are attached to the rear head restraint and retention snaps are attached.

Vehicle Function Checks

- Rear cargo door

Rear cargo door should open and close freely without interference from the cargo cover
