Procedure

Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Inspect the Parts for Preparation.

- (a) Open the package and check the parts for damage and kit contents.
- (b) Remove any cargo and debris from the rear cargo area.

2. Install the Cargo Liner.

- (a) With the third row seats up, place the folded cargo liner in the cargo area (Fig. 2-1) (Fig. 2-2).
- (b) Installation is complete.



NOTE: Do NOT fold third row seats down when the cargo liner is in the cargo area.

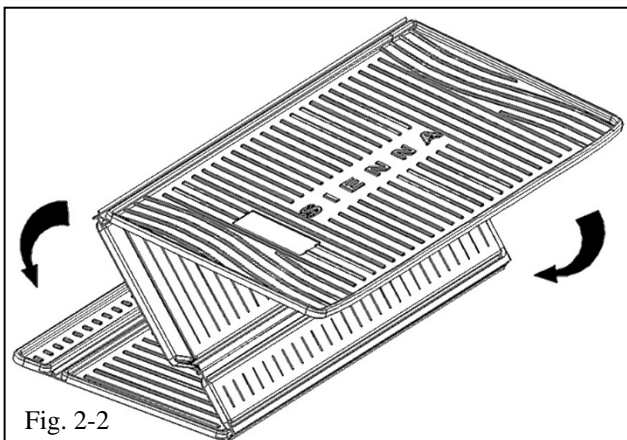

<u>Accessory Function Checks</u> <input type="checkbox"/> Correct part number has been installed.	Verify part number on package.
<u>Vehicle Function Checks</u> <input type="checkbox"/> Confirm rear tail gate closes completely	Verify gate fully closed
<u>Vehicle Appearance Check</u> <input type="checkbox"/> After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection. Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process.
