



1. Prepare to Mount the Front Mudguards.


(a) Clean and degrease the front body where the mudguard will be located with a clean cloth and soap/water mixture (Fig. 1-1).

- (b) Remove and discard the exisiting push pins at locations A and B (Fig. 1-2).
- (c) Remove and discard the exisiting bolt at location C (Fig. 1-2).

- (d) Pull the liner forward and install the supplied spring clips (wide) with the turned-up edge on the inside of the panel; center the clips on the panel holes at location A (Fig. 1-3).
- (e) Reposition the liner.








2. Install the Front Mudguards.

- (a) Hold the part up and into the body panel (Fig. 2-1).
- (b) Install the supplied #14 x 19mm (thick) screw in locations B then C (Fig. 2-1). Do not over tighten the screw.
- (c) Install the supplied M5x 20mm (thin) screws in location A while holding part up and into body panel then tighten. (Fig. 2-1)

NOTE: Do not over tighten the screws.


(d) Hold the part up and into the body panel and drill an 8mm (5/16") hole in location D (Fig. 2-2).

- (e) Hold the part up and into the body panel and install a supplied push pin (small) into location D (Fig. 2-3).
- (f) Repeat Steps 1 and 2 on the other side of the vehicle.




3. Prepare to Mount the Rear Mudguards.

(a) Clean and degrease the rear bumper cover where the mudguard will be located with a clean cloth and soap/water mixture (Fig. 3-1).



- (b) Remove and discard the exisiting push pin at location C (Fig. 3-2).
- (c) Pull the liner forward and install the supplied spring clip (narrow) with turned up edge inside of the rear seal (top piece) center clip on seal hole location C (Fig 3-2).
- (d) Reposition the liner so that it sits between the rear bumper and the supplied spring clip installed on the rear seal (Fig. 3-2).




4. Install the Rear Mudguards.

- (a) Slide the tab under the bumper flange, then push it up and into position (Fig. 4-1).
 - (b) Hold the part up and into the body panel and install supplied #14 x 19mm (thick) screws in location B (Fig. 4-1).

NOTE: Make sure the tab is under the bumper flange and pushed up into position before installing the screws.

(c) Hold the part up and into the body panel and install a supplied #14 x 19mm (thick) screw in location A (Fig. 4-1).



- (d) Hold the part up and into the body panel and install a supplied M5 x 20mm (thin) screw in location C (Fig. 4-2).
- (e) Repeat Steps 3 and 4 on the other side of the vehicle.
