## 1. PREPARATION

(a) Open the package and check part for damage.
(b) Open cargo hatch and remove any stored items or debris from cargo area.

## 2. INSTALL THE CARGO TRAY

(a) Place cargo tray in the cargo compartment with the logo towards the rear of the vehicle and facing up (Fig. 2-1) (Fig. 2-2).
(b) After installing the tray, ensure all of the edges are pushed down against the floor.

## 3. COMPLETE THE INSTALLATION

(a) Close the cargo hatch.
