
Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).




1. PREPARATION


- (a) Open package and check part for damage and kit contents.
- (b) Remove any debris from rear cargo area.
- (c) Place vehicle protection over the rear bumper.

2. INSTALL THE CARGO TRAY

- (a) Place Cargo Tray in Cargo Area with logo towards the rear of the vehicle and facing up. (Fig 2-1)
- (b) Grasp the tray by the rear (widest end) and fold in the sides sufficiently to slide it into the rear compartment. After installing the tray, ensure all of the edges are pushed down against the floor. (Fig 2-2)



- (c) **FOR CUSTOMER ONLY (OPTIONAL):**
To use the cargo area hooks, place the cargo tray over a cardboard surface and cut the designated area with a utility knife. You may either remove the panel completely or cut the perforated area to make a flap that would lock closed with the notched area. (Fig 2-3)



3. COMPLETE THE INSTALLATION

- (a) Remove the vehicle protection.
- (b) Close Tail gate.
