# 1. Align the Seat Cover


- (a) Align the seat protector over the second-row seat.
- (b) Locate the three (3) foam inserts between seat back and base on the back side of seat cover (Fig. 1-1).

### 2. Insert the Foam Block


(a) Push each foam insert into the crevice between the seat and seat back (Fig. 2-1).




(b) The foam inserts must be compressed, inserted, and allowed to re-expand to maintain proper retention.







**NOTE:** For the left and right seats, there are hard plastic panels in the seat crevice.

(c) Foam inserts must be placed behind the plastic panel to re-expand (Fig. 2-2).

(d) For the center seat, foam insert must be placed below the seat crevice obstruction, rather than above, for best retention (Fig. 2-3).




(a) Attach the hook and loop straps around seatback, making sure the straps do not interfere with any seat components and child seat restraint anchor points on back of seats (Fig. 3-1).



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
