Confirm that the net is attached properly to the anchor points in the vehicle.	Confirm pull tab is facing toward the rear of the vehicle.  Confirm all clips are properly attached to the D-Rings of the vehicle.
Vehicle Function Checks  Vehicle hatch door operation.	Confirm vehicle hatch door opens and closes without interference from Cargo Net.
Vehicle Appearance Check  After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.	Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)
