





1. Installation of Cargo Net

(a) Fold both rear seats flat, and locate the anchor positions for both as indicated by the arrows (Fig 1-1).

(b) With the zippers closed, lay both nets flat on the seats with zippers pulls oriented as indicated (Fig 1-2).

(c) Release all four velcro straps. Starting at one corner, loop the velcro strap under and around pin (Fig 1-3).




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- (d) Pull the strap, align velcro and fasten to the webbing as shown (Fig 1-4).
- (e) Repeat steps 1(c) & 1(d) for the remaining three corners



- (f) Repeat steps 1(c), 1(d) for all corners except lower left
- (g) For lower left, pull strap through and align both Velcro fasteners and attach. (Fig 2-2)

(h) Completed assemblies (Fig 1-5).




2. Cargo Net Use



(a) The large net has a feature that allows for the loading of larger objects. Unsecure the lower left strap and temporarily attach only the end of the velcro to the webbing. (Fig 2-1). Open the zipper and insert items into the net.



(b) Close zipper, pull strap, align velcro and fasten to the webbing as shown (Fig 2-2).
