


## 1. Installation of Cargo Net.

- (a) Open hatch, locate anchor locations on the driver's side of the vehicle (Fig 1-1.)
- (b) Attach loop at the top of the net to the vehicle anchor as shown (Fig. 1-2).
- (c) Attach hook at the bottom of the net to the D-ring on the vehicle as shown (Fig. 1-3).







- (d) Review driver's side attachment (Fig. 1-3).
- (e) Repeat steps 1(a) through 1(d) for the passenger side of the vehicle.
- (f) Confirm completed assembly. Make sure net handle is facing out toward the rear of the vehicle (Fig. 1-4).
