Section II ☐ Installation Procedure

A. Attach Cargo Cover

1. Open rear liftgate and locate anchor points on each side of the vehicle. (Fig. A-1)



2. Flip open sides of cargo cover. Attach hooks to D-rings as shown. Repeat for other side of vehicle. (Fig. A-2)



3. Adjust tension on cargo cover by holding the tensioning buckle in one hand and pulling the web strap in the opposite direction as shown. Repeat for other side of vehicle. (Fig. A-3)



- i. Ensure that cover is centered across the vehicle.
4. Flip sides of cargo cover back down. Final assembly should resemble (Fig A-4).

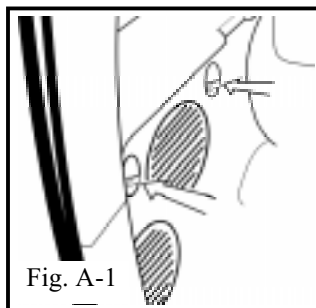

Section III ☐ Functional Verifications

Check:

- ☐ Confirm that the cargo cover is attached properly to the anchor points in the vehicle.
- ☐ Confirm that the cargo cover is properly tensioned.
- ☐ Confirm that the cargo cover is properly centered across vehicle.

Look For:

Make sure hooks are attached to the D-rings on both sides of the vehicle.

Make sure straps have been tightened on both sides of the cargo cover.

Make sure gap between side edges of cover, on each side, and body panel is symmetrical.
