



(b) Disengage the two (2) clips, then remove the front floor foot rest. (Fig. 2-2)


- (c) Remove the left side cowl side trim board in the following steps. (Fig. 2-3)
 - (1) Remove the one (1) plastic cap.
 - (2) Disengage the two (2) clips, then remove the left side cowl side trim board in the direction of arrow.
- (d) Disengage the nine (9) claws, then remove the left side rear door scuff plate in the direction of arrows. (Fig. 2-4)


- (e) Remove the left side front seat belt anchor plate in the following steps. (Fig. 2-5)
 - (1) Slide the driver seat forward.
 - (2) Disengage the two (2) claws, then remove the left side front seat belt anchor cover.
 - (3) Unbolt and remove the left side front seat belt anchor plate from the center pillar.

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
(4) In order to prevent scratches to the panels, apply protection tapes around the anchor plate and installation bolt. (Fig. 2-6)


- (f) Remove the left side center pillar lower garnish in the following steps. (Fig. 2-7)
 - Remove the left side front door opening trim weather strip from the left side center pillar.
 - (2) Remove the left side rear door opening trim weather strip.
 - (3) Disengage the two (2) clips and two (2) claws, then remove the left side center pillar lower garnish in the direction of the arrows.
- (g) Remove the auxiliary box in the following steps. (Fig. 2-8)
 - (1) Fold up the rear seat cushion.
 - (2) Remove the in-vehicle tools and jack.
 - (3) Remove the nine (9) clips then remove auxiliary box.


3. Disassembly of Vehicle.


(a) Disengage the ten (10) claws, then remove the left side front door scuff plate in the direction of arrows. (Fig. 3-1)

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
(b) Disengage the two (2) clips, then remove the front floor foot rest. (Fig. 3-2)


- (c) Remove the left side cowl side trim board in the following steps. (Fig. 3-3)
 - (1) Remove the one (1) plastic cap.
 - (2) Disengage the two (2) clips, then remove the left side cowl side trim board in the direction of arrow.
- (d) Disengage the eight (8) claws and one (1) clip, then remove the left side rear door scuff plate in the direction of arrows. (Fig. 3-4)




- (e) Remove the rear seat cushions in the following steps. (Fig. 3-5)
 - (1) Remove the six (6) bolts.
 - (2) Remove the left and right rear seat cushions.

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
(f) Remove the four (4) bolts, and then remove the rear lower console box. (Fig. 3-6)


- (g) Remove the two (2) bolts, then remove the rear lower console box bracket. (Fig. 3-7)
- (h) Remove the auxiliary box in the following steps. (Fig. 3-8)
 - (1) Remove the in-vehicle tools and jack.
 - (2) Remove the twelve (12) clips then remove auxiliary box.

4. Install the Tuner.

- (a) Prior to applying adhesive sheets, clean the mounting areas with a 3MTM Prep Sol-70.
- (b) Apply two (2) adhesive sheets A to the vehicle panel as shown in the figure. (Fig. 4-1)




(c) Apply one (1) adhesive sheet B to the tuner as shown in the figure. (Fig. 4-2)


- (d) Install the connectors to the tuner. (Fig. 4-3)
 - (1) Install the connectors of tuner cable, antenna cable, and ground cable to the tuner.
 - (2) Secure the tuner cable to the tuner as shown in the figure by using one (1) cushion tape.





- (e) Attach the tuner to the location shown in the illustration on the body. (Fig. 4-4)
 - (1) Peel the separator from adhesive sheets A.
 - (2) With the separator still in place, bring adhesive sheet B into contact with the bottom, and then slide it along until it comes into contact with the side of the body.
 - (3) Stick adhesive sheets A onto the side.
 - (4) Peel the separator from adhesive sheet B.
 - (5) Apply pressure from the top to make sure adhesive sheet B is firmly stuck in place.















- 5. Route the Tuner Cable, Antenna Cable, and Ground Cable. (Model with Double Cab)
 - (a) Route and fix the tuner cable, antenna cable, and ground cable to the vehicle with the five (5) cushion tapes as shown.(Fig. 5-1)
 - (1) Be sure to cover sharp edge with foam tape.

- (b) Disengage the three (3) clamps of the left side front door wire harness and three (3) clamps of the left side rear door wire harness. (Fig. 5-2)
- (c) Route the tuner, antenna, and ground cables as shown, and then secure them with the three (3) lock ties and one (1) cushion tape as shown. (Fig. 5-3)
- (d) Use the side cutter to cut off the excess lock ties length.
- (e) Route the tuner, antenna, and ground cables as shown, and then secure them with the three (3) lock ties. (Fig. 5-4)
- (f) Use the side cutter to cut off the excess lock ties length.










- (g) Connect the tuner cable connector of tuner cable in the following steps. (Fig. 5-5)
 - (1) Remove the tape binding the connector to the wire harness, and pull the connector as shown.
 - (2) Connect the tuner cable connector of tuner cable to the vehicle wire harness connector pulled in step (1).
- (h) Connect the antenna cable connector of antenna cable to the vehicle wire harness connector as shown in the figure. (Fig. 5-6)

- (i) Install the end of the ground cable connector of ground cable onto the ground bolt located on the cowl side. (Fig. 5-7)
- (1) Be sure to orient the cable connector from the front side of vehicle to avoid interference with cowl trim when reinstalled.
- (j) Secure the tuner cable, antenna cable and ground cable with the lock tie in the following steps. (Fig. 5-8)
 - (1) Bundle excess cables in cowl area and secure to vehicle wire harness with three(3) lock ties
- (k) Use the side cutter to cut off the excess lock ties length.


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
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- 6. Route the Tuner Cable, Antenna Cable, and Ground Cable. (Model with Access Cab)
 - (a) Route and fix the tuner, antenna, and ground cables to the vehicle with the five (6) cushion tapes as shown.(Fig. 6-1)
 - (1) Be sure to cover sharp edge with foam
 - (b) Disengage the seven (7) clamps of the left side door wire harness. (Fig. 6-2)
 - (c) Route the tuner, antenna, and ground cables as shown, and then secure them with the four (4) lock ties. (Fig. 6-3)
 - (d) Use the side cutter to cut off the excess lock ties length.


- (e) Connect the tuner cable connector of tuner cab le in the following steps. (Fig. 6-4)
 - Remove the tape binding the connector to the wire harness, and pull the connector as shown.





(2) Connect the tuner cable connector of tuner cable to the vehicle wire harness connector pulled in step (1).


- (f) Connect the antenna cable connector of antenna cable to the vehicle wire harness connector as shown in the figure. (Fig. 6-6)
- (g) Install the end of the ground cable connector of ground cable onto the ground bolt located on the cowl side. (Fig. 6-7)
 - (1) Be sure to orient the cable connector from the front side of vehicle to avoid interference with cowl trim when reinstalled.




- (h) Secure the tuner cable, antenna cable and ground cable with the lock tie in the following steps. (Fig. 6-8)
- (i) Bundle excess cables in cowl area and secure to vehicle wire harness with three (3) lock ties.
- (j) Use the side cutter to cut off the excess lock ties length.


7. In Process Functional Test.

- (a) Temporarily reconnect negative battery cable.
- (b) Turn the ignition key to "ACC" position.
- (c) Press the power button on the receiver/player head unit.
- (d) Press and release the "SAT" button on the head unit.
 - Verify that a satellite channel is received, or a "NO SIGNAL" message appears on the display.
- **NOTE:** If "ANTENNA" appears (flashing) on the display then the antenna cable of Cord Assy is disconnected from the satellite tuner.
- **NOTE:** If the head unit will not tune or go into satellite mode then the tuner cable of Cord Assy is disconnected from the satellite tuner.
 - (e) Disconnect negative battery cable.
- 8. Complete the Reassembly of Vehicle.
 - (a) Install the left side center pillar lower garnish and weather strips in position.(Model with Double Cab)
 - (b) Install the left side front seat belt anchor plate bolt. (Model with Double Cab) (Fig. 8-1)
 - (1) Tighten bolt to 42 N·m (31 lbf·ft).
 - (c) Install the rear seat cushions.(Model with Access Cab) (Fig. 8-2)
 - (1) Tighten bolt to 18 N·m (13 lbf·ft).









9. Reconnect Battery Cable

- (a) Reconnect the vehicle negative battery cable.(Fig. 9-1)
 - (1) Position the negative terminal to the battery as shown (original factory position).
 - (2) Tighten the nut to $3.9 \text{ N} \cdot \text{m}$ (36 lbf·in).
 - (3) Do not touch the positive terminal with any tool when installing the cable.
- (b) Clean up and remove any trash.
- (c) Place the owner "XM Satellite Radio" brochure in the glove box.
- (e) Perform the RID registration process.

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
