This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

**1. Vehicle Preparation.**

- (a) Open vehicle rear cargo door and lower the 3<sup>rd</sup> row seats.

**2. Installation of the Cargo Cover.**

- (a) Locate the cargo cover mounting points on the passenger side of the cargo compartment (Fig. 2-1).

-  (b) Place the right end of the cargo cover into the mounting point while keeping hold of the left side. Then raise the left side and place the left end into the driver's side mounting point.

-  (c) Pull out the cargo cover and engage both ends in hook area to secure it (Fig. 2-2).

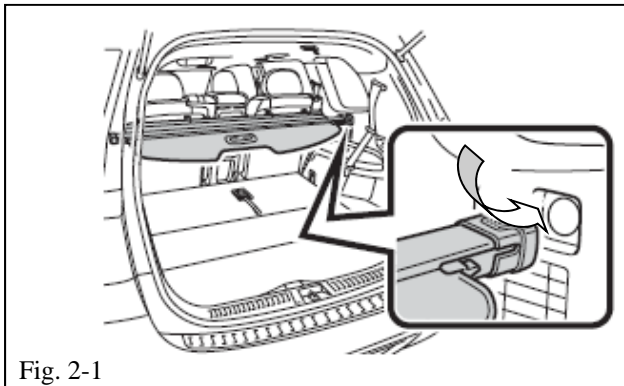

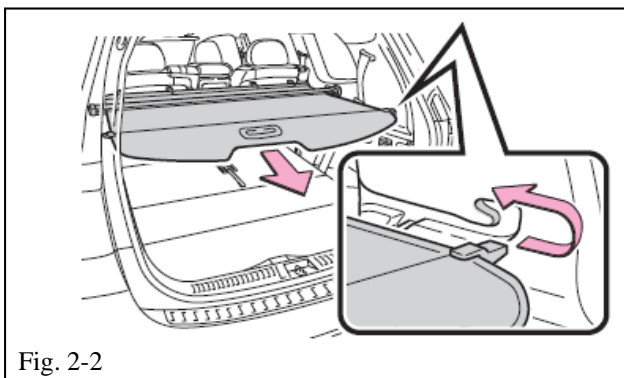

Checklist - these points **MUST** be checked to ensure a quality installation.

<u>Check:</u>	<u>Look For:</u>
<p><u>Accessory Function Checks</u></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Confirm the cover is attached properly to the anchor points in the vehicle.</p>	<p>Make sure the end caps of cassette are fully inserted in the pockets.</p> <p>Make sure end points are fully seated in the anchor points.</p>
<p><u>Vehicle Function Checks</u></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Rear cargo door</p>	<p>Rear cargo door should open and close freely without interference from cargo cover</p>
<p><u>Vehicle Appearance Check</u></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.</p>	<p>Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)</p>
