


1. Prepare the Vehicle.


- (a) The part and vehicle surface temperature must be maintained between 65°F and 90°F for optimum installation. Store parts flat at room temperature in a clean dry place.
- (b) Clean the entire application surface to remove grease and wax. Clean the entire area with a VDC approved cleaner and cleaning method.
 - (c) Wipe the cleaned surface with a clean, dry, lint-free cloth.


2. Install the Rear Bumper Applique.


(a) Place the part face down on a clean flat surface. Remove the entire liner backing (Fig. 2-1).












(f) Use long, smooth overlapping strokes with the squeegee from the center outwards of the horizontal section and begin to wrap over the bumper (Fig. 2-5).



(g) Carefully remove the pre-mask paper 180° against itself prior to squeegeeing the final wrap area (Fig. 2-6).

(h) Use a sharp squeegee with a protective sleeve to make smooth overlapping downward strokes from the center outwards of the final wrap area of the vertical section (Fig. 2-7).



NOTE: Check to make sure there are no air bubbles under the applique. Re-squeegee if necessary.

(i) Dry off the vehicle with a clean, lint-free cloth.
