**Procedure**

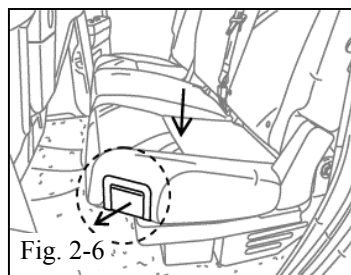
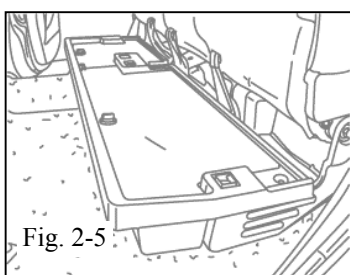
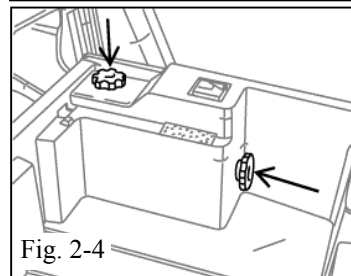
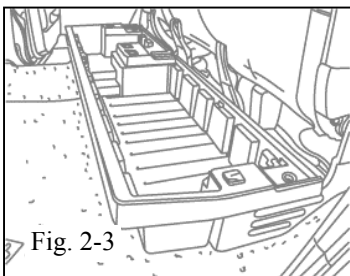
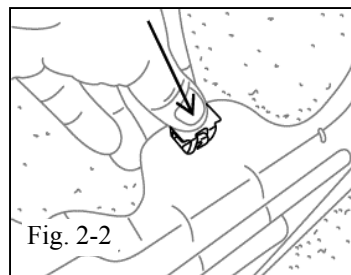
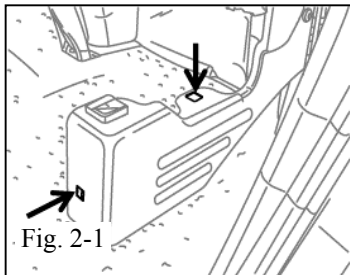
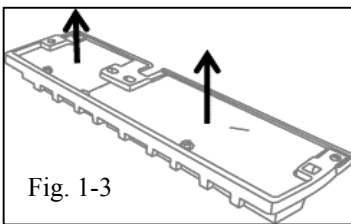
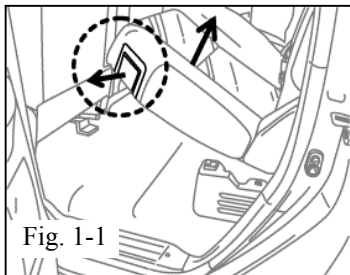
Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

**1. Preparation.**

- (a) Open rear doors.
- (b) Raise rear seat cushions. Pull on lever to release. (Fig. 1-1)
- (c) Apply floor protection. (Fig. 1-2)
- (d) Open carton and inspect kit for content and Remove the (2) covers. (Fig. 1-3)

**2. Install the Under Seat Tray.**

- (a) On the seat brackets, press (1) screw retainer clip into each of the (4) holes indicated. 2 per side, driver side shown. (Figs. 2-1 & 2-2)
  - (1) Orientation of the clip is not critical.
- (b) Place the Under Seat Tray onto the seat brackets as shown. (Fig. 2-3)
- (c) Install (1) knob into each of the (4) previously installed screw retainer clips. 2 per side, driver side shown. (Fig. 2-4)
  - (1) Tighten hand tight.

**3. Post Installation**

- (a) Replace and lock the lids. (Fig. 2-5)
- (b) Lower the seat cushions. Pull on lever to release. (Fig. 2-6)
- (c) Remove vehicle protection.
- (d) Close rear doors.
