This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).

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- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

### 1. Prepare for the Install.

- (a) Open the package and check the part for damage and kit contents, including the adapter pads attached to the seat back covers.
- (b) Open the rear hatch door and remove any stored items and debris from the cargo area.
- (c) Place vehicle protection over the rear bumper.
- (d) Open both the rear driver and rear passenger doors and lower the seatbacks down.

### 2. Modify the Cargo Floor.

(a) Remove the cargo floor from the vehicle and place it upside down on a clean, dry surface (Fig. 2-1).





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- (b) Locate the two spring assemblies on the back of the cargo floor. Insert either a large flattip screw driver or needle-nose pliers into the rectangle openings (Fig 2-2).
- (c) Rotate the tool to remove the attachment.
- (d) Repeat on each spring holder to remove them entirely.
- (e) Place the two spring assemblies into a ziplock bag and place the bag in the glove compartment.
- (f) Leave the cargo floor out of the vehicle while performing the next steps.

(a) Before removing the white covers from the adapter pads, align the driver side seat back cover with the seam lines of the seat back (Fig. 3-1).



- (b) Check to ensure the seat latch is centered in the opening. Adjust the cover if needed (Fig. 3-2).
- (c) Rub firmly along the bottom edge of the cover to secure the hook fastener to the seat.



- (d) Grasp the front edge of the seat back cover and slowly bend the cover up and rearward to reveal the adapter pads. Remove the white cover from the 5 pads and lower the cover down onto the seat back. Firmly rub the cover over the adapter pad locations to ensure attachment (Fig. 3-3).
- (e) Repeat Steps 3(a) through 3(d) on the passenger side.

**NOTE:** The passenger side has 8 adapter pads.

# 4. Install the Cargo Tray.

(a) Reinstall the vehicle cargo floor that was removed in Step 2(a) and secure it in place (Fig. 4-1).



- (b) Place the Cargo Tray in the cargo area with the logo towards the rear of the vehicle and facing up (Fig 4-2).
- (c) After installing the tray, ensure all of the edges are pushed down against the floor.

# 5. Complete the Installation.

- (a) Remove the vehicle protection.
- (b) Close the doors.
