TOYOTA Procedure

Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Prepare the Vehicle.

- (a) The part and vehicle surface temperature must be maintained between 65°F and 90°F (18°C and 32°C) for optimum installation. Store parts flat at room temperature in a clean dry place.
 - (b) Place a protective blanket in the trunk area to protect from overspray of wetting agent.
 - (c) Clean the entire application surface to remove grease and wax Clean the entire area with a VDC-approved cleaner and cleaning method (Fig. 1-1)
 - (d) Wipe the cleaned surface with a clean, dry, lint-free cloth.

2. Install the Rear Bumper Applique.

(a) Align the center notch directly below the striker latch opening and the leading edge of the liner to the rearward ridge on the bumper. (Fig. 2-1).









(b) Flip over the right side of the bumper applique and remove the liner section (1) while holding and pulling with section (2) (Fig. 2-2).

- (c) While holding the bumper applique over the bumper, begin to squeegee the top part of the bumper applique at section (1), using firm overlapping strokes onto the bumper while keeping a constant visual edge (Fig. 2-3).
- (d) Remove section (2) (Fig. 2-3) and squeegee the top of the part keeping a constant visual alignment of the bumper applique to the fascia edge of the bumper by holding section (5) in place (Fig. 2-4).

NOTE: Ensure the bumper applique does not fold over and make contact with the vertical edge of the bumper fascia. This is critical to avoid trapping air.

- (e) Repeat step 2(b) for the left side of the bumper applique making sure sections (4) and (5) remain in alignment with the fascia edge. (Fig. 2-5).
- (f) Remove sections (4) & (5) and squeegee the part onto the vehicle.
- (g) Starting at the center of the bumper applique, only squeegee the edges outwards using firm overlapping strokes (Fig. 2-6).



(h) Inspect the bumper applique for any damage or incorrect installation. Repair or replace as necessary (Fig. 2-7).

Check:	Look For:
Accessory Function Checks	
Proper adhesion – Visual	Look for bubbles, loose and lifting edges.
Proper adhesion – Physical	With light pressure, rub a hand over the top of the part and if a crackling sound occurs, re-squeegee. If bubbles cannot be worked out to the nearest edge, replace the part.
Proper alignment – Cross-Car	The part must be centered within +/-3 mm.
Vehicle Appearance Check	
After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.	Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)
