


Procedure









Checklist - these points **MUST** be checked to ensure a quality installation. Check: Look For: **Accessory Function Checks** Correct part number has been installed Verify part number on package. Nut torque 55 N-m (40.5 ft/lbf) Clamp alignment Clamp oriented with bolt on the right side with the nut facing down Toyota logo facing up Tip alignment **Vehicle Function Checks** Rattle or vibration Start engine and check for rattles or vibration of the exhaust tip. Vehicle Appearance Check After accessory installation perform a Ensure no damage (including scuffs and visual inspection. scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)
