


1. Prepare Vehicle for Safe Installation.

(a) Verify the kit contents (hardware bag contents Fig. 1-1).



NOTE: Key set will be in smaller bag.



- (b) Remove front cup holder spacers from the coin holder / tray in the console box and install them in the front cup holders (Fig. 1-2).
- (c) Discard the coin holder / tray.




- (d) Confirm 3-digit number on keys matches with 3-digit number on side of lock (Fig. 1-3).

NOTE: Do NOT remove key set from smaller bag.




NOTE: 3-digit number on side of lock is located under the lid.



(e) Remove the console box carpet at the bottom (Fig. 1-4).




NOTE: Do NOT discard the console box carpet.




2. Remove Factory Mounting Hardware.


(a) Remove and discard the (4) factory mounting screws from the bottom of the center console (Fig. 2-1).



3. Place Aluminum Spacers.

- (a) Insert the (4) aluminum apacers into the recesses in the bottom of the center console (Fig. 3-1).
- (b) Center aluminum spacers as closely as possible over mounting points.





- (a) Open console safe lid (combination is set at 0-0-0 from the factory).
- (b) Lower the console safe into position in the bottom of the center console. The open lid will be oriented toward the passenger side of the vehicle (Fig. 4-1).


5. Secure the Console Safe into Center Console.

- (a) Install 1) Flat Washer to each 30mm Cap Screw.
- (b) Secure the Console Safe in place by installing the Cap Screw / Flat Washer assembly to each of the 4 holes.



NOTE: The (4) 30mm Cap Screws come with thread locker already applied.

- (c) Tighten the Screws to 6.7 N-m (59 in-lbs) (Fig. 5-1).
- (d) Locate the console box carpet from step 1 and place it into the console vault.
- (e) Place console safe in locked position.
- (f) Place the keys and lock documentation in the vehicle glove box.
