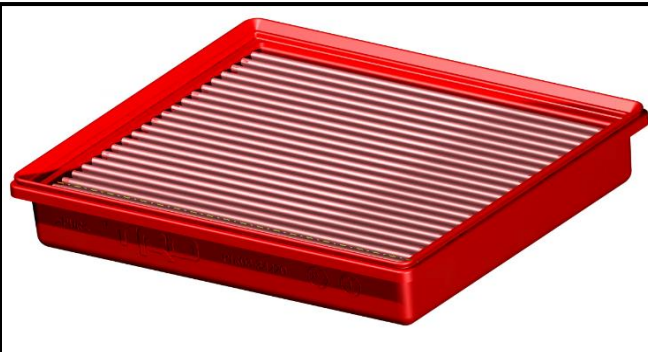
REVISION MARK: This mark highlights a change in installation with respect to previous issue.

Procedure

Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Prepare the Vehicle and Parts.



(a) Check the box for contents and any damage.

(b) Open the vehicle hood.

(c) Familiarize yourself with the installation and components before beginning.



(d) Apply vehicle protection to prevent damage to painted surfaces.



(e) **NOTE:** Two (2) TRD Performance Air Filter kits (PTR03-34220) are required for a complete installation.

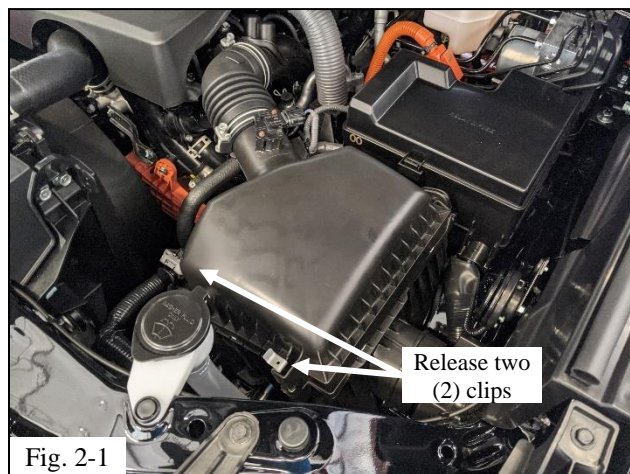

2. Remove the Driver-Side Factory Air Filter.

(a) Unlatch the two (2) air filter housing clips (Fig. 2-1).

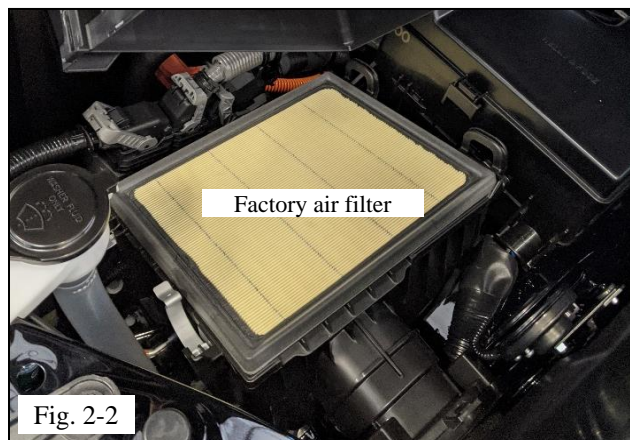
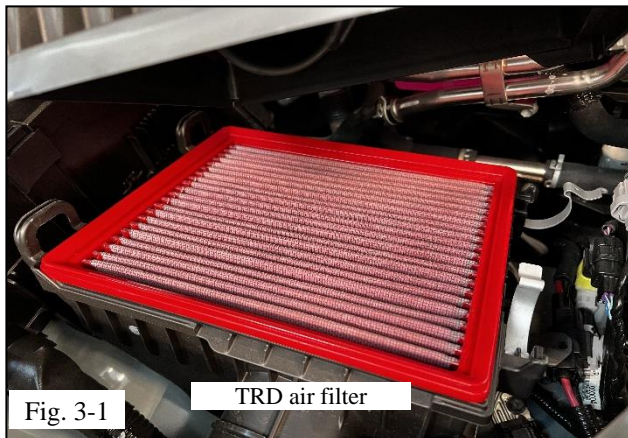

(b) Lift the filter housing lid up to expose the factory air filter (Fig. 2-2).

(c) Remove the factory air filter from the filter housing and discard it.

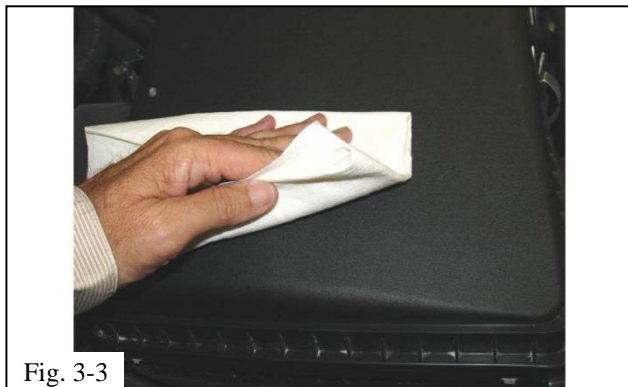
Procedure

**3. Install the Driver-Side TRD Air Filter.**

- (a) Insert the TRD air filter into the air filter housing with the deep side of the filter down in the housing (Fig. 3-1).



- (b) Move the air filter housing lid into place and engage the two (2) tabs (Fig. 3-2).
- (c) Re-latch the two (2) air filter housing clips (Fig. 2-1).



- (d) Use a lint free cloth and a VDC-approved cleaner such as 3M Prep Solvent 70 or similar to clean the air filter housing lid (Fig 3-3).

Procedure**4. Install Passenger-Side Air Filter**

- (a) Repeat Steps 2-3 to install second TRD Performance Air Filter to the passenger-side air intake

5. Apply TRD Air Filter Care Label

Note: Only 1 Label needs to be applied, discard additional labels.

- (a) Use a lint free cloth and a VDC-approved cleaner such as 3M Prep Solvent 70 or similar to clean the under hood for application location A or B (Fig. 5-1).
- (b) Orient label “upright” as indicated by arrows and apply the TRD air filter care label to the pre-cleaned area. (Fig. 5-1).

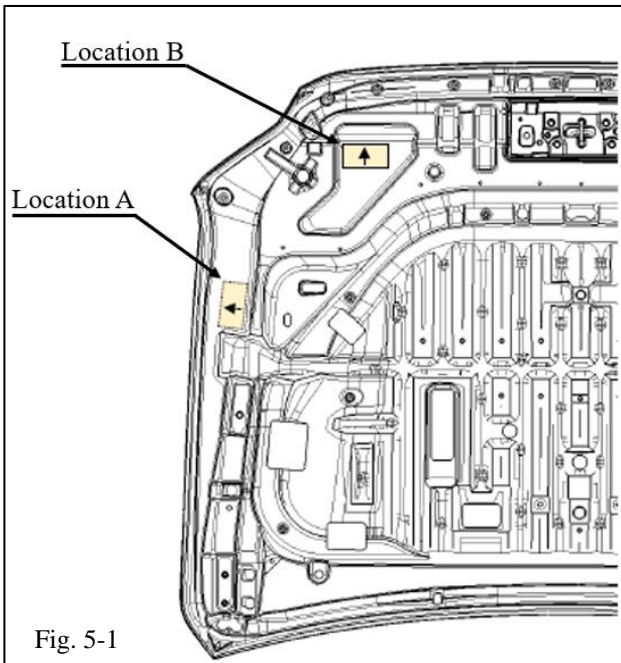

6. Finish the Installation.

- (a) Remove the vehicle protection used to prevent damage to painted surfaces.

Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process.
