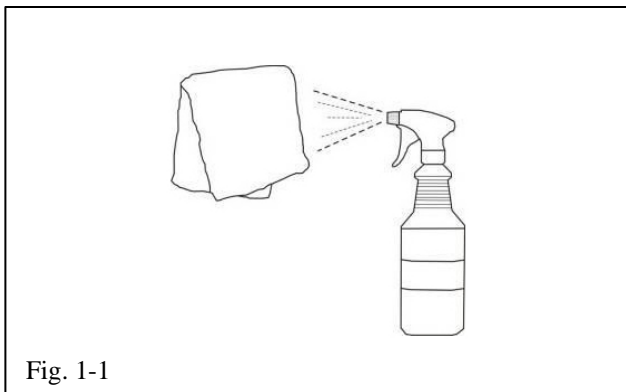
Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

Please see your Toyota dealer for a copy of this document.



1. Prepare for the Installation.

- (a) Thoroughly clean all of the installation surfaces.

NOTE: Always use a clean, lint-free scratch resistant cloth.

NOTE: Shake VDC cleaner well.

- (b) Apply VDC cleaner directly to the cloth (Fig.1-1).

NOTE: Do NOT spray cleaning solutions directly to vehicle.

- (c) Clean the surfaces thoroughly and wipe dry immediately with a new clean cloth.

NOTE: Do not allow cleaner to air dry.

NOTE: (d) Emblem cap and vehicle installation surface must be between 70°F and 110°F at time of installation.

NOTE: A heat source may be used to reach minimum temperature if necessary.

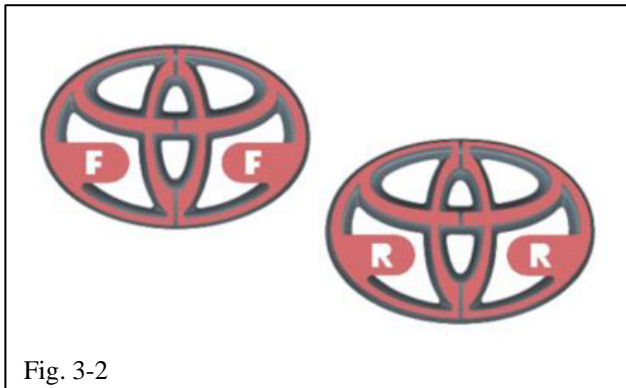
2. Verify Kit Contents.

- (a) Inspect the kit for contents and damage.

NOTE: Reference vehicle part availability tables for vehicle trim specific emblems.

3. Install the Front Emblems (if Kit is Equipped).

- (a) Check fitment of the emblem cap over the factory chrome emblem (Fig. 3-1).

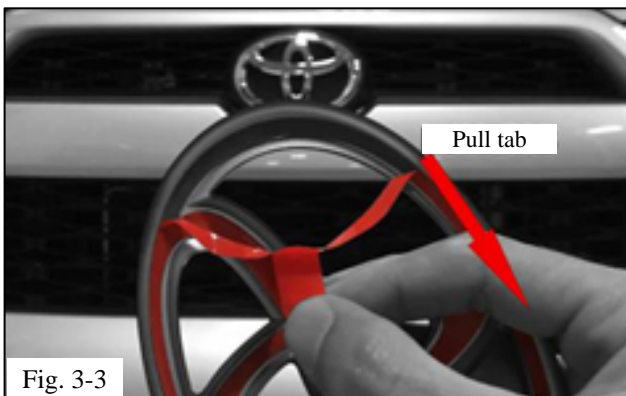


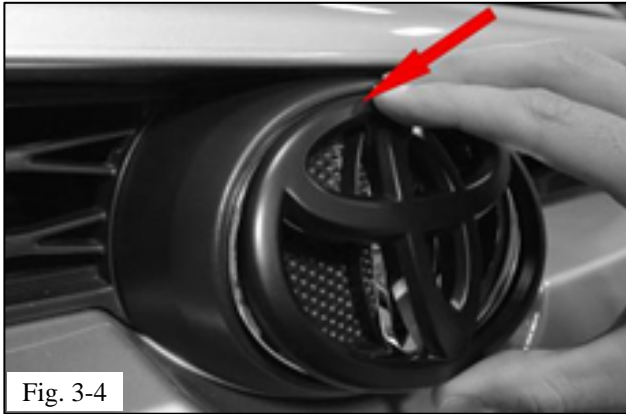
NOTE: Certain emblem caps are front or rear specific. They may be labelled as “Front” or “Rear” or may have an “F”, or an “R” cut into the pull tab to indicate a front or rear emblem cap respectively (Fig 3-2). Incorrect installation will result in poor fit and incomplete badge coverage.

NOTE: Unlabeled emblem caps are not front or rear specific.

- (b) Using the pull tabs, pull gently to remove the adhesive liners from the backside of the emblem cap (Fig. 3-3).

NOTE: Do not touch the adhesive during installation.





- (c) Position the emblem cap over factory emblem starting from the top edge then downward, ensuring it is centered (Fig. 3-4 & 3-5).



NOTE: Do not touch the adhesive during installation.



- (d) Visually verify that the emblem cap is positioned correctly over the factory emblem and press lightly to adhere (Fig. 3-5).



- (e) Using a lint-free scratch resistant cloth, press firmly on the emblem cap from the center working outwards to the edges of the emblem cap, to ensure maximum adhesion contact (Fig. 3-6).

4. Install the Side Emblems (if Kit is Equipped).

NOTE: Steps 4(a) through 4(f) show an “SR5” side emblem install for reference. The procedure is the same for side emblems across Toyota models.

NOTE: Certain emblem caps are side specific. They may be labelled as “Passenger Side” or “Driver Side” (Fig 4-1). They may also have blue pull tabs for Driver Side and green pull tabs for Passenger Side (Fig 4-2). Incorrect installation will result in poor fit and incomplete badge coverage.

NOTE: Unlabeled side emblem caps are not side specific.

- (a) Check fitment of the emblem cap over the factory chrome emblem (Fig. 4-3).

- (b) Using the pull tab, pull gently to remove the adhesive liner from the backside of the emblem cap (Fig. 4-4).

NOTE: Do not touch the adhesive during installation.



- (c) Position the emblem cap over factory emblem starting from the top edge then downward, ensuring it is centered (Fig. 4-5 & 4-6).



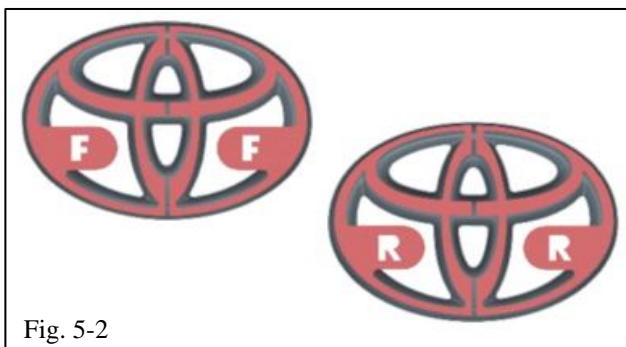
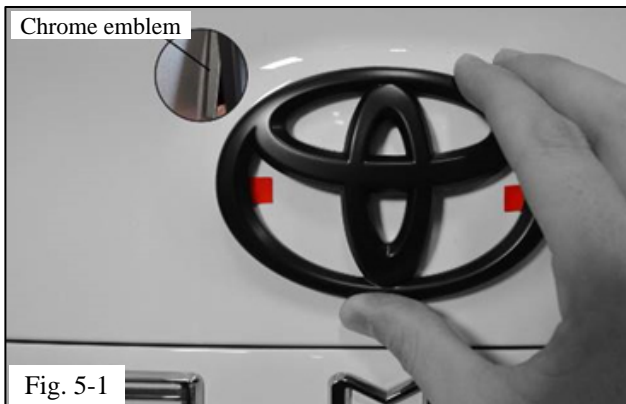
- (d) Visually verify that the SR5 emblem cap is positioned evenly over the factory emblem and press lightly to adhere (Fig. 4-6).



- (e) Using a lint free cloth, press firmly on the emblem cap from the center working outwards to the edges of the emblem cap, to ensure maximum adhesion contact (Fig. 4-7).
- (f) Repeat on the other side of the vehicle if necessary.

5. Install the Rear Emblems (if Kit is Equipped).

- (a) Check the fitment of the emblem cap over the factory chrome emblem (Fig. 5-1).

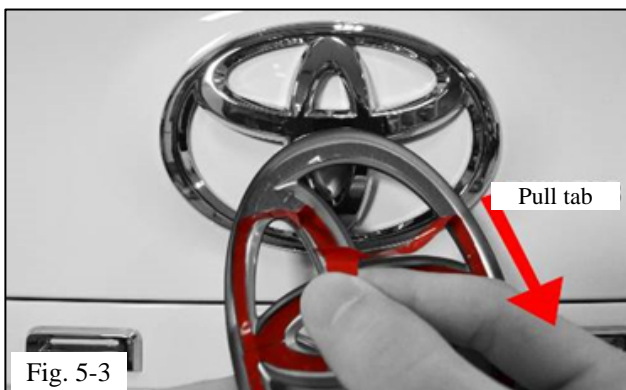


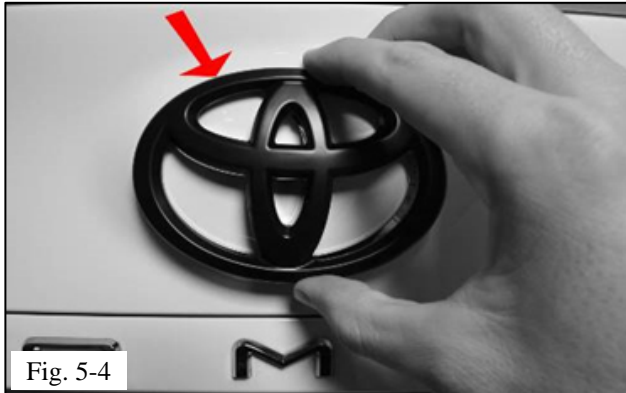
NOTE: Certain emblem caps are front or rear specific. They may be labelled as “Front” or “Rear” or may have an “F”, or an “R” cut into the pull tab to indicate a front or rear emblem cap respectively (Fig 5-2). Incorrect installation will result in poor fit and incomplete badge coverage.

NOTE: Unlabeled side emblem caps are not side specific.

- (b) Using the pull tab, pull gently to remove the adhesive liner from the backside of the emblem cap (Fig. 5-3).

NOTE: Do not touch the adhesive during installation.





- (c) Position the emblem cap over the factory emblem starting from the top edge then downward, ensuring it is centered (Fig. 5-4 & 5-5).

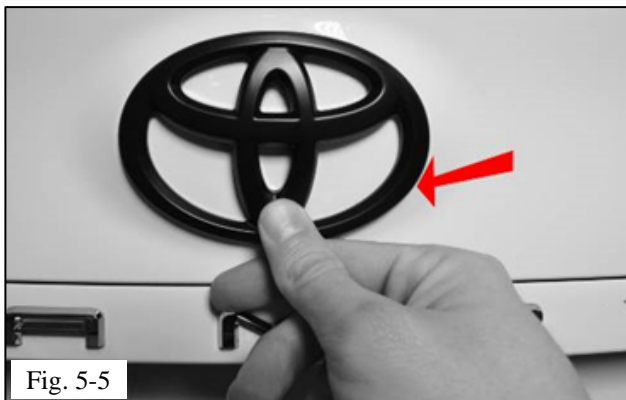

(d) Using a lint-free scratch resistant cloth, press firmly on the emblem cap from the center working outwards to the edges of the emblem cap, to ensure maximum adhesion contact (Fig. 5-6).

NOTE: Steps 5(e) through 5(h) shows the procedure to install one exterior emblem letter. The process outlined should be followed with each subsequent letter on applicable vehicles.

SEQUOIA EMBLEM CAP KIT

PT948-0C200-02 / PT948-0C201-02: Fig. 5-7 shows the correct orientation of the letters with the pull tabs from the rear of the emblems showing. Ensure during installation that the orientation of the letter is such that the pull tabs for the “O” and the “I” are located at the top right side of the part as shown. Failure to orient these parts properly will result in improper installation.

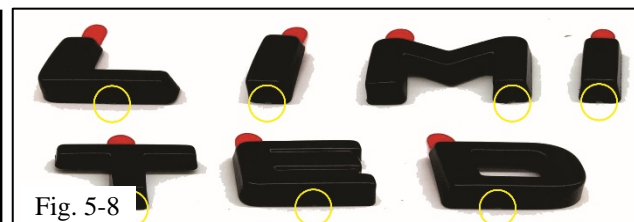
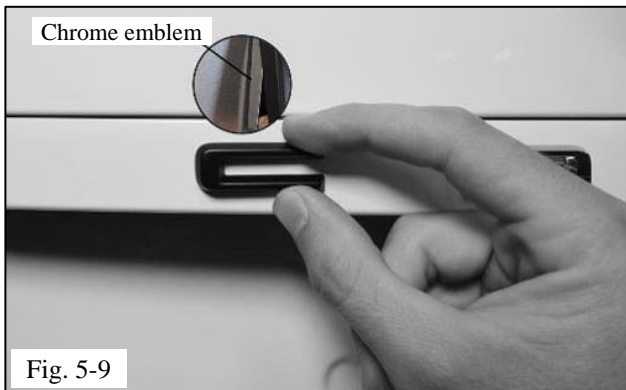

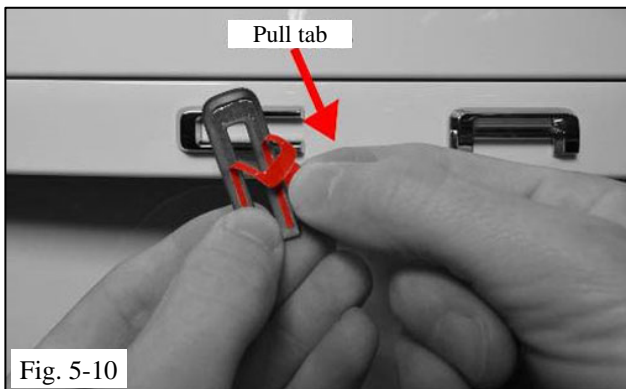
HIGHLANDER LIMITED / LIMITED AWD EMBLEM CAP KITS

PT948-48205-02 / PT948-48206-02

To ensure proper install and fitment of parts, proceed with the “HIGHLANDER” emblem caps prior to installation of the “LIMITED” emblem caps. Emblem caps for the “LIMITED” badge will not fit properly on the “HIGHLANDER” badge and vice versa. The “LIMITED” emblem caps are notched at the bottom to aid in identification at installation time as shown in Fig. 5-8.

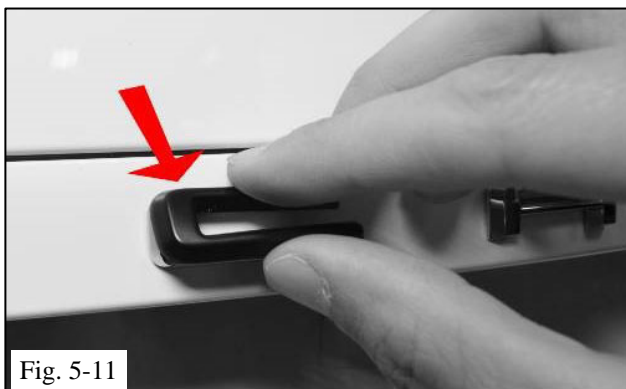


- (a) Check the fitment of the emblem cap over the factory chrome emblem (Fig. 5-9).



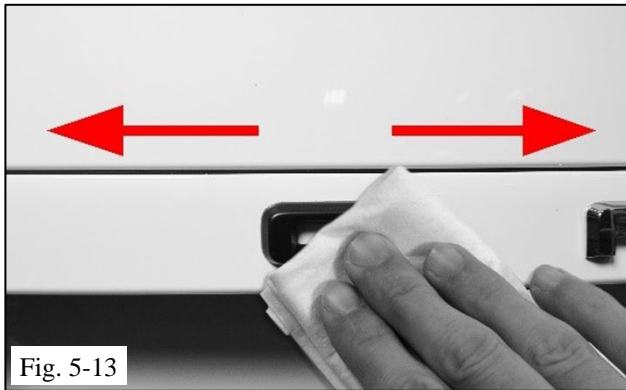
- (b) Using the pull tab, pull gently to remove the adhesive liner from the backside of the emblem cap (Fig. 5-10).

NOTE: Do not touch the adhesive during installation.



- (c) Position the emblem cap over the factory emblem starting from the top edge then downward, ensuring it is centered (Fig. 5-11 & 5-12).

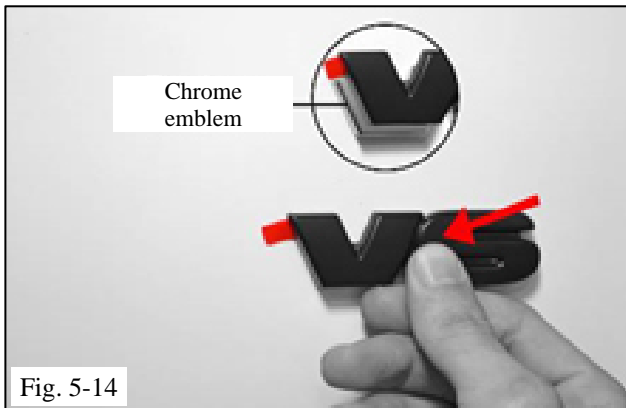




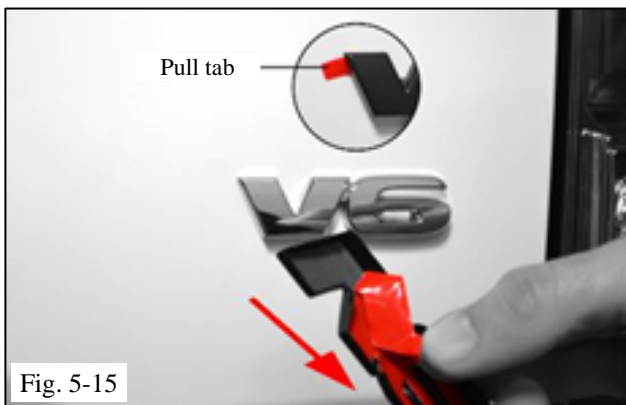
- (d) Using a lint-free scratch resistant cloth, press firmly on the emblem cap from the center working outwards to the edges of the emblem cap, to ensure maximum adhesion contact (Fig. 5-13).

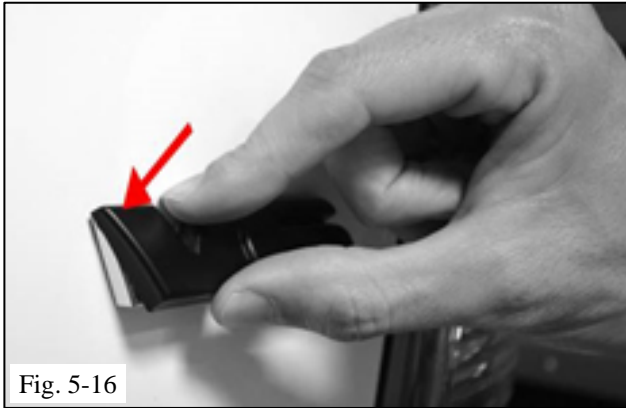
NOTE: Steps 5(i) through 5(l) show the procedure to install a single piece trim emblem. The process outlined should be followed with each subsequent single piece emblems on applicable vehicles.

- (e) Check fitment of emblem cap over factory chrome emblem (Fig. 5-14).



- (f) Using the pull tab, pull gently to remove the adhesive liner from the backside of the emblem cap (Fig. 5-15).





- (g) Position the emblem cap over the factory emblem starting from the top edge then downward, ensuring it is centered (Fig. 5-16 & 5-17).



- (h) Using a lint-free scratch resistant cloth, press firmly on the emblem cap from the center working outwards to the edges of the emblem cap, to ensure maximum adhesion contact (Fig. 5-18).

6. Destroy/Discard Unused Emblem Caps.

- (a) Emblem kits may contain emblem caps for several trim levels, and non-applicable badge caps. Destroy then discard any unused emblem caps.
